**AMERICAN HEART ASSOCIATION CPR,
AED, and FIRST AID COURSES**

For all CPR courses, students should dress for practice on training manikins, some of which may be on the floor. Many courses come with a student CD-ROM that requires a Windows-based PC.

**PROFESSIONAL CPR - BASIC LIFE
SUPPORT FOR HEALTHCARE PROVIDERS**

This is the professional-level CPR training for people who have a primary responsibility to respond to patients in an emergency.

An American Heart Association BLS for the Healthcare Providers card that is current on the date of the skill session is required to register. There is no extension or grace period by starting this process. Students must submit proof they completed the on-line renewal at www.onlineaha.org no more than 60 days prior to their skill session. Candidates must come prepared and should take no more than 15 minutes for their skill session. Students who require significant remediation will be directed to repeat a regular course.

BLS INSTRUCTOR (\$175*)

This workshop prepares participants to offer the entire array of AHA CPR, AED, and first aid programs. Qualified candidates must have a:

- o Current BLS for Healthcare Providers card
- o Documented sponsorship from an American Heart Association Training Center
- o Mastery of BLS and CPR information and skills from the 2005 Guidelines for CPR and ECC.
- o Commitment to teach a minimum of two courses per year for their sponsoring AHA Training Center.

The process begins with verification of model CPR skills and written testing. Candidates who demonstrate adequate skill performance may continue in the workshop. The process concludes with successful participants being monitored while teaching in an actual course which is mutually scheduled. There is a registration deadline for the workshop.

LAY-RESCUER CPR, AED, and FIRST AID

These offerings are designed for the general public and lay rescuers. They provide basic information and practical skills for use at home or the workplace, appropriate for workplace safety teams, security guards, day care staff, teachers, coaches, babysitters, civic groups, church organizations, etc.

Heartsaver CPR and AED (\$50*)

Covers CPR for adults, children and infants, help for someone choking and use of an automated external defibrillator (AED). 6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.. Register for one session. Offered on:

CPR AND FIRST AID

We offer any of the American Heart Association CPR and First Aid courses by request to groups to meet your needs or the requirements of regulated OSHA training for your company.

CPR Courses

- Family and Friends CPR (CPR for all ages, intended for the general public)
- Heartsaver Adult & Child CPR (For lay rescuers who need a formal CPR card)
- Heartsaver AED - Adult & Child CPR and use of automated external defibrillator (For lay rescuers who need a formal CPR card)
- Heartsaver Pediatric CPR (For lay rescuers who need a formal CPR card)
- BLS for Healthcare Providers (health professional-level CPR)

First Aid Courses & First Aid with CPR

- Heartsaver First Aid
- Heartsaver First Aid with CPR and AED - first aid, adult CPR, and use of automated external defibrillator
- Heartsaver Pediatric First Aid with CPR and AED - for victims younger than 8 years old

EPI-PEN TRAINING

Orients lay rescuers to the use of a prescribed epinephrine auto-injector for allergic emergencies in a school or workplace setting.

ARE YOU READY? AN IN-DEPTH GUIDE TO CITIZEN PREPAREDNESS

Designed by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to help citizens learn how to protect themselves and their families against all types of hazards. Focuses on how to develop, practice, and maintain emergency plans for what must be done before, during, and after a disaster to protect people and their property. Also includes information on assembling a disaster supplies kit. The course is designed to be presented in 2.5 hours. Registration, Refund and Cancellation Information

- ALL REGISTRATIONS MUST BE PRE-PAID. No seats will be reserved or certificates/credit awarded without payment.
- No refunds or credits will be issued for incomplete coursework, failures, or absences.
- Except where noted, refunds for cancellations will be based on the number of BUSINESS DAYS BEFORE THE COURSE the cancellation is RECEIVED according to the following schedule:
 - 10 OR MORE: Full refund minus the cost of any issued materials unless they are returned in brand new condition (no damage, wear, marks or writing) **BEFORE the start of the class.**
 - LESS THAN 10: No refund.
- Student substitutions for a particular course are allowed up to the end of the business day before the course begins without fee or penalty.
- Available seats are filled on a first come-first served basis. Only preregistered students will be notified if the course is cancelled or rescheduled.
